The Project Designer contributes to the development of graphics and maintains our graphic brand standards. They will be intimately involved in all aspects of a project including research, analysis and the development of the overall vision for a site's design and transformation. The project designer is expected to develop efficient software skills and workflows that are central to success in this role. They will also develop strong time management habits, and clear communication/collaboration techniques to mitigate any roadblocks that may arise.

The Project Designer is also proactive in checking their own work for accuracy and legibility, and actively gathers precedents and examples of exceptional graphics that they use as a guide to successful execution of their own work. Project Designers are introduced to the Project Delivery Manual and it is used as a resource to learn how to most effectively interface with the team as they collectively deliver work for a project. Proficiency should also be attained in firm standards such as managing files on the server, systems used in project management (e.g. agendas, file sharing, etc) and graphic brand and documentation standards.
